SAFETY RULES ARE TO BE STRICTLY OBSERVED ON THE TERMINAL AND / OR ON VESSELS / BARGES ETC.

BY ENTERING THE TERMINAL YOU ACKNOWLEDGE TO UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THESE AND OTHER SAFETY RULES.

Do not drive past red line alongside quay, danger!



During work in operational areas it is obligated to wear an approved safety helmet on the terminal.



Wear personal protective equipment; think about safety/reflective clothing!



Do not block crane tracks.



Stay clear of operations in vehicles/containers.



It is obligated to wear safety shoes.



Do not leave any garbage behind.



Beware of falling when working on heights. Use of safety harness required, for example when working in a cherry picker.



On the terminal 15 km/h is the speed limit. Further Dutch road regulation is applied. Beware: RHB traffic precedes pedestrians and/or other traffic.



Where indicated or if written in (work) instructions eye and/or ear protection is required.



It is strictly prohibited to be found under (lifted) cargo.



Where indicated or if written in (work) instructions: dust or breath protection is required.



Beware of driving equipment/machinery.



It is not allowed to enter or leave a vessel, or any form of floating equipment, by other means than the gangway.



Beware: You are working on the terminal or on (floating) equipment/machinery with relevant hazards: stay alert!



Please note that the terminal is under constant camera surveillance.



It is strictly prohibited to find yourself in the reach of cranes/machinery; always make eye contact with the driver. Do not place yourself behind any machinery.



If an accident occurs there is a reaction plan: you are to follow the instructions of the assigned rhb staff.

The use, possession and to be under the influence of alcohol and drugs is prohibited.
